### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

The "churh order" discourse - In today's Gospel reading, Matthew 18:15-20, Jesus addresses a common occurrence in the Christian community: a dispute between two members of the Church. Jesus outlines a procedure for settling such matters fairly. The victim should privately address the offender and attempt to resolve the dispute without outside involvement. If that fails, then the victim should bring two or three witnesses and confront the offender again. If the dispute is still unresolved, the matter should be brought to the attention of the entire community. If the offender refuses to adhere to the reparations prescribed by the community, then Jesus suggests that the offender may be expelled from the Church. Jesus does not discourage disagreement within the community of the Church; he acknowledges the reality of conflict and error and offers his disciples a means for addressing such matters.

# CELEBRATION OF THE SOLEMNITY OF ST. MICHAEL & CONFERRRAL OF THE PALLIUM

The Archdiocese of Toronto celebrates the feast day of our archdiocesan patron, St. Michael, on Fri., Sept 29<sup>th</sup>. All are welcome to join in a special celebration on that day at 5:30 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica (65 Bond St.). Archbishop Francis Leo will celebrate Mass, with music from the world-renowned St. Michael's Choir School. As part of the celebration, the Apostolic Nuncio to Canada, the Most Rev. Ivan Jurkovič will confer the pallium on our archbishop, a symbol of his role as Metropolitan Archbishop of Toronto and shepherd to the faithful. Mass, there will be an informal reception with light refreshments in the St. Michael's Cathedral atrium and courtyard. Seating will be first come, first served. All are welcome to join in this special celebration for our archdiocese and archbishop!

### MEDITAZIONE SPIRITUALE

La Correzione Fraterna - Gesù ci consegna lo stesso insegnamento del profeta Ezechiele, delineando però una vera strategia di intervento per soccorrere il fratello che sbaglia: «Se il tuo fratello commetterà una colpa contro di te, va' e ammoniscilo fra te e lui solo; se ti ascolterà, avrai guadagnato il tuo fratello». Avere il coraggio di rivolgere al fratello una parola franca, a tu per tu e al momento opportuno, ci libera dal rischio di covare rancore nei suoi confronti, di mormorare contro di lui rivolgendoci a un terzo, di sentirci migliori di lui, osservando la pagliuzza che è nel suo occhio senza accorgerci della trave che è nel nostro (cf Mt 7,3). E può anche aprirci alla capacità di accogliere a nostra volta la correzione, quando saremo noi a cadere in errore. Il primo passo, dunque, è il gesto delicato del colloquio: un colloquio che deve restare segreto e nascosto, affinché il fratello possa percepire chiaramente che il nostro passo nasce dalla sola preoccupazione di aiutarlo a ritornare sulla via di Dio: a noi deve stare a cuore la conversione del fratello e non la sua umiliazione.

In questa logica di autentica compassione nei confronti del fratello che «commette una colpa», c'è anche un'altra cosa che bisogna assolutamente evitare: è la divulgazione sciocca e maligna della colpa del fratello! (don Lucio D'abbraccio)
