#### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

**Stay Awake** - Our Lord encourages us to stay awake. Staying awake, in practice, means having the light of faith, which is kept alive with the oil of charity.

The parable centers on the attitude one should adopt up to the time when the bridegroom comes. In other words, it is not sufficient to know that one is "inside" the Kingdom, that one "belongs" to the Church: one has to be on the watch and be preparing for Christ's coming by doing good works and by fulfilling God's Will.

Anything which implies indifference to God's Will, living life for one's self and living for this world would constitute a spiritual slumber which would lead to nefarious consequences at the end of one's life.

The vigilance to which God invites us to live should be continuous and untiring, because the devil is always after us, prowling around "like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour" (I Pet 5:8). (Young Catholics Striving for Holiness)
